

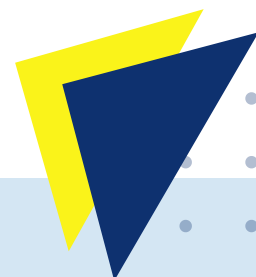

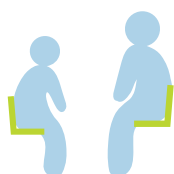

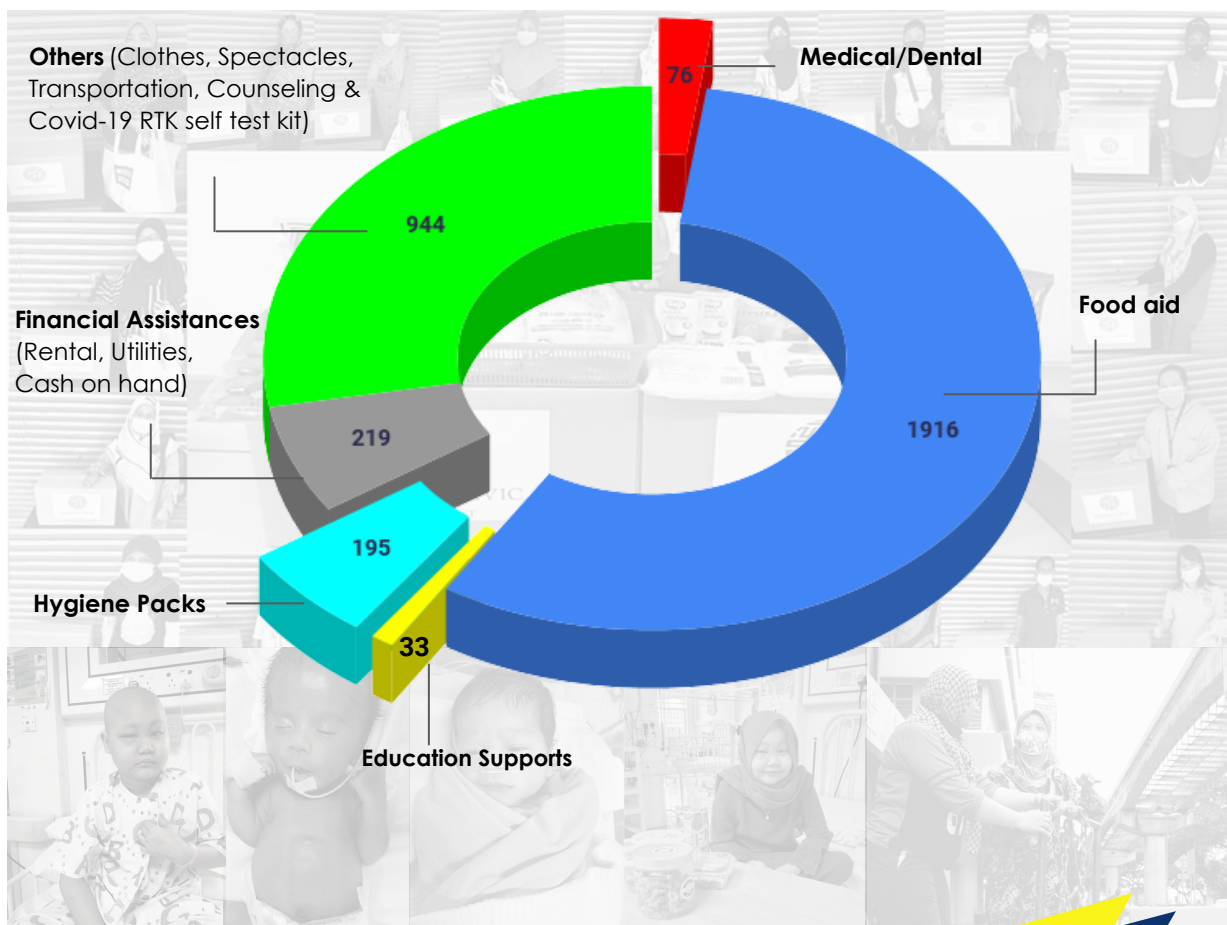

I. TOTAL CASES RECEIVED

From January until November this year, Yayasan Chow Kit has received a total of 3383 cases. Out of this number, medical/dental 76 cases, food aid 1916 cases, education supports 33 cases, hygiene packs 195 cases, financial assistance (rental, utilities, cash on hand) 219 cases and others (clothes, spectacles, transportation, counseling & RTK self test kit) 944 cases.

TOTAL CASES BREAKDOWN

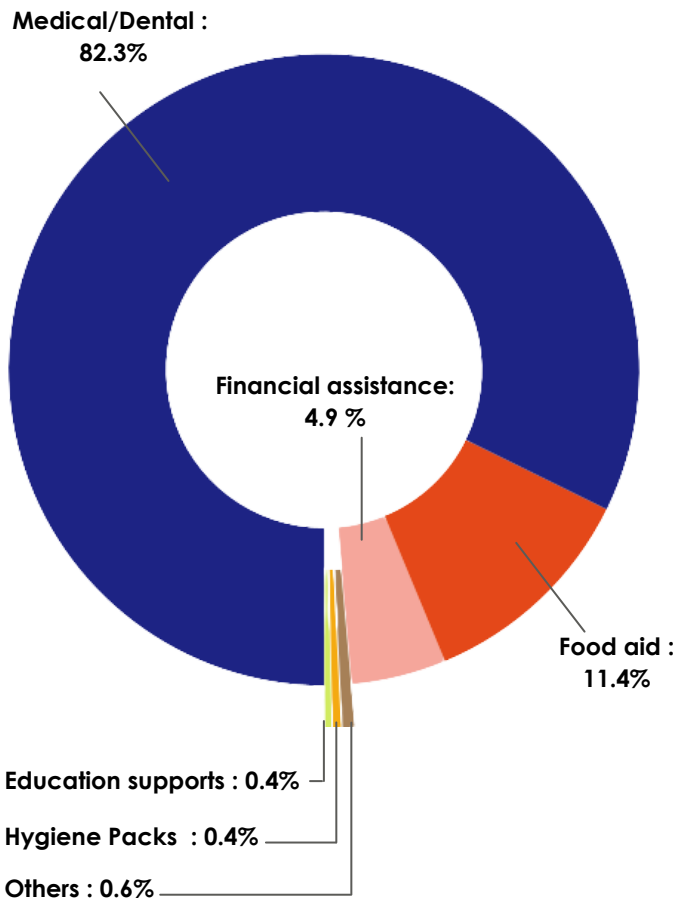

II. TOTAL CASE MANAGEMENT COST

Yayasan Chow Kit has spent a total of RM1,722,967.60 on all cases from January 2021 until November 2021. Almost 82.3% of the fund were spent on medical/dental whereby 11.4% on food aid, 4.9 % on financial assistance (rental, utilities, cash on hand), 0.4% on education supports, 0.4% on hygiene packs, and 0.6 % on others (clothes, spectacles, transportation, counseling & RTK self-test kit).

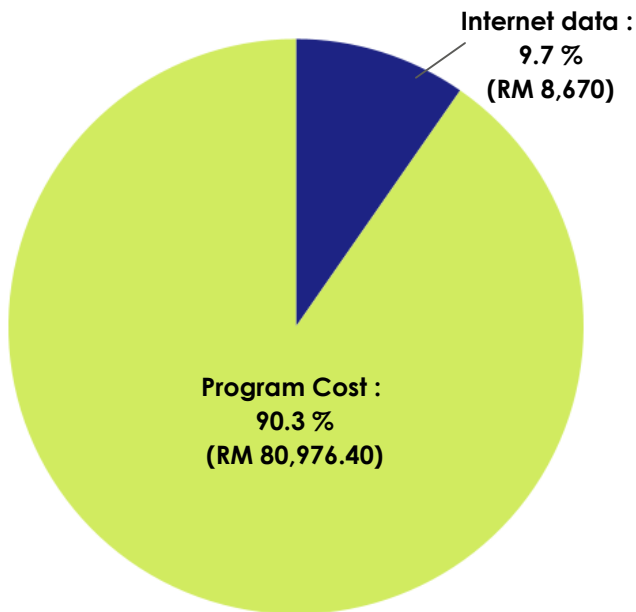

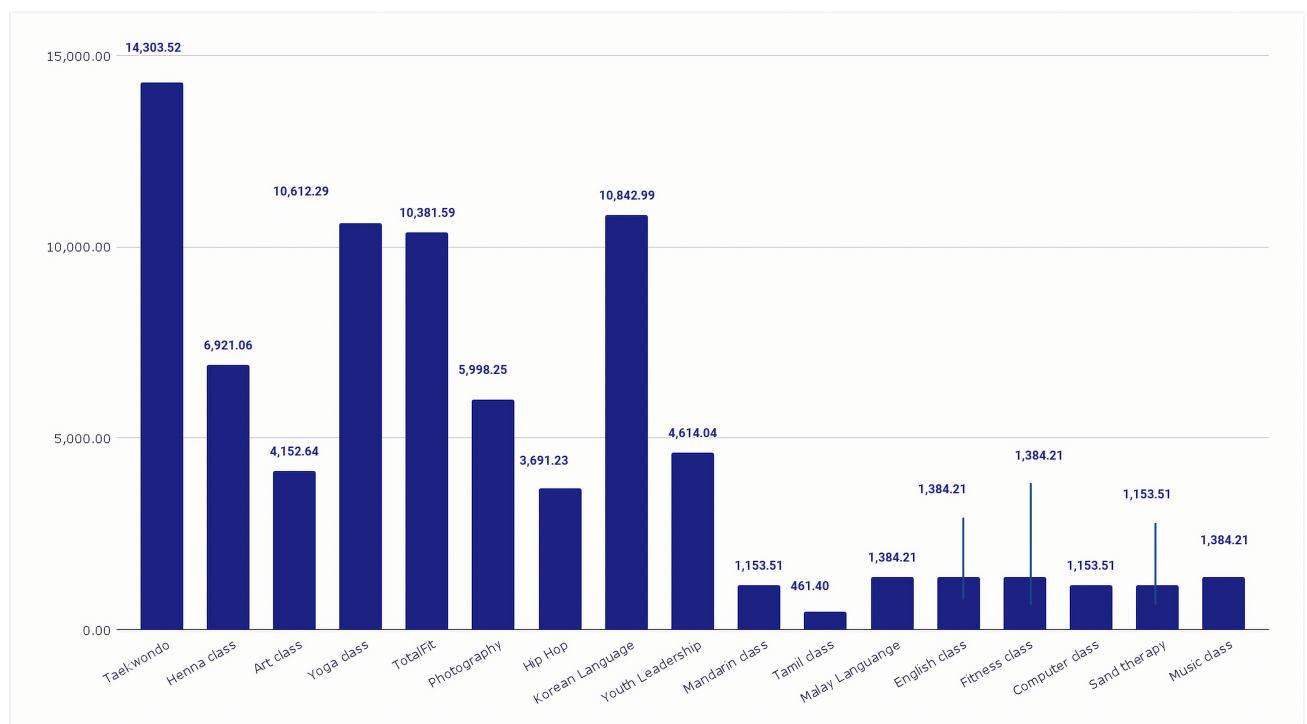

RM 89,646.40**

Yayasan Chow Kit has spent a total of RM89,646.40 on programs in KL centres and shelter from January 2021 until November 2021. Almost 90.3% (RM 80,976.40) of the fund were spent on program cost whereby 9.7% (RM 8,670) on internet data.

TOTAL PROGRAM COST BREAKDOWN



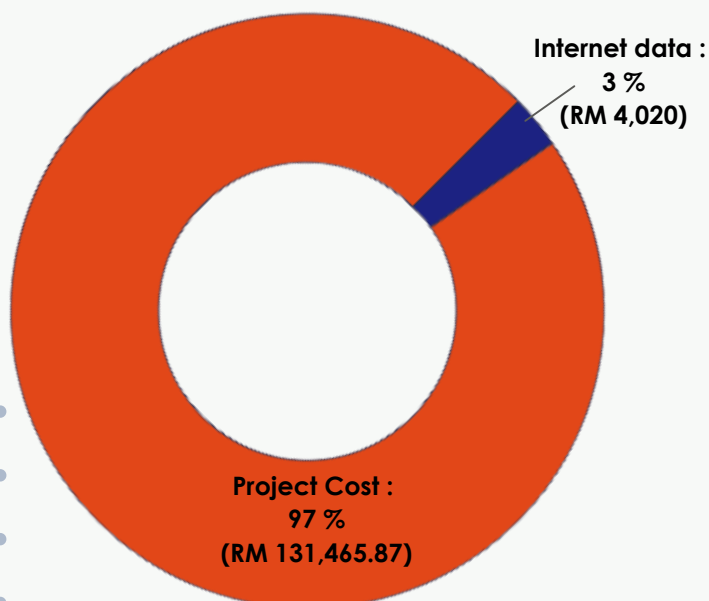
06 HOMESCHOOLING

Yayasan Chow Kit provides homeschooling for children who are not able to attend government school. This could be due to challenges in documentation or citizenship. All homeschooling students are taught by certified teachers.

Yayasan Chow Kit has spent a total of RM135,485.87 on the homeschooling program from January 2021 until November 2021. Almost 97% (RM 131,465.87) of the fund were spent on project cost whereby 3% (RM 4,020) on internet data.

4. THE TALISMAN PROJECT

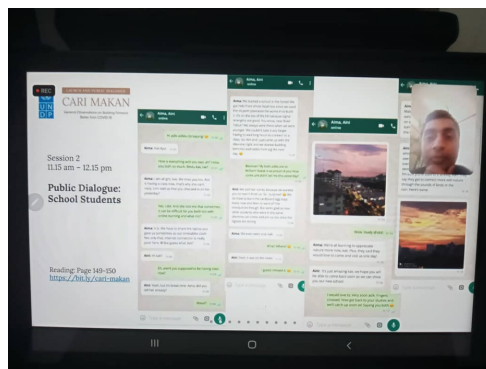
